



ADHD* ASSESSMENT

*Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder

ADHD is one of the most common neurodevelopmental disorders, usually first diagnosed in childhood and often lasting well into adulthood.

ADHD is not an intellectual disability or learning disorder, but they can occur together. ADHD impacts global skills and executive functions like the ability to focus, the ability to control emotions and the ability to control impulsive behaviour.

Individuals with ADHD commonly display symptoms relating to inattention, impulsivity and hyperactivity, such as:

- Impulsiveness
- Disorganisation and problem prioritising
- Poor time management skills
- Difficulty focusing on a task
- Trouble multi-tasking
- Excessive activity or restlessness
- Poor planning, initiating and completing of goal-directed activities
- Problems regulating emotions, low frustration tolerance

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

A detailed report offering a well-rounded understanding (rather than judgment) of a person's difficulties and subsequent non-preferred or unwanted behaviour as well as recommendations and strategies to support them to develop the skills to live a rewarding and meaningful life and reach their full potential.

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

- Up to three interviews: with the client, legal guardian, a parent/carer or teacher
- Questionnaires for the client, a teacher and parent/carer
- Report writing
- Feedback session

Test administered:

- **Connors Comprehensive Behavior Rating Scale (Connors-3)**
*** Vision and hearing tests are also recommended to assess other possible explanations for ADHD-related behaviour*

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE?

It takes approximately three to four weeks from the first meeting until you receive the final report.

LOCATION

Meetings take place at one of our FABIC offices, depending on what is most supportive for the client. On-site visits are possible and travel costs apply.

COSTS

Costs vary depending on each person's needs and are based on the clinician's standard fee (contact FABIC for details).
